





New Features - Planned

Planned System upgrades to support data extraction, aggregation, and analysis:

- Interactive dashboards and graphical outputs using Superset
- Custom scripts for advanced data analysis through JupyterLab
- Export of maps and geospatial datasets

Role of Contracting Parties

CPs are invited to conduct internal assessments based on:

Availability of national data

Alignment with National monitoring plans

Feedback from national IMAP users










Support from INFO/RAC

A dedicated form has been developed to support the structured submission of proposals, which will be discussed collaboratively with CPs.









CORMON Biodiversity and Fisheries (7-8 April 2025, Athens)

To support a more structured evaluation of proposed changes and strengthen collaboration among Contracting Parties, the Meeting recommended the establishment of an **Online Working Group** dedicated to the fine-tuning of all available information standards on Biodiversity.











STATE OF ART OF THE IMAP REPORTING

Introduction

- IMAP Info System allows contracting parties to communicate data for the 19 IMAP Common Indicators, including Candidate Indicator 24 (*Trends in the amount of litter ingested by or entangling marine organisms focusing on selected mammals, marine birds, and marine turtles*).
- 30 Information Standards have been developed and implemented in the IMAP Info System, including Candidate Indicator 24.


Utilization and submission of IMAP Data Reporting Standards

- 30 Information Standards developed to support IMAP data reporting
- <u>A</u> Limited usage by CPs despite full availability
- Very few files submitted overall





No. of submitted files per submission year



































Temporal Coverage of Reporting

- Monitoring years reported are very limited
- • We are now in the second monitoring cycle
- 1 Data from the first cycle (up to 2021) still not submitted → Deadline was 2023
- | Data gaps detected





Status of IMAP Data Submissions

- Many files remain in Draft status
 - → suggests process is stalling early
- Very few reach Compliant or Valid status
 - → could suggest issues with data quality, structure, or completeness
- Dublished files are extremely limited
 - → contradicts MAP Data Policy


DATA METRIC POLICY

Principles behind prescriptions: open access

Following the principles behind UNEP/MAP Data Policy, Annex I of the decision (UNEP/MED IG.25/27, Decision IG.25/10): data must be as open as possible, respecting the constraints imposed by local legislation, sensitivity of data and copyrights

To formalize Open Access, we need **Open Data licenses**:

- Public Domain (CC-0)
- Creative Commons Attribution (CC-BY)









Principles behind prescriptions: restriction and embargo

- Restrictions to put attention on are:
 - Binding rules
 - International treaties
 - National legislation
 - Statistical confidentiality
 - Protection of intellectual property rights
 - Protection of national security
 - Defense purposes
 - Public security

- Embargo is a temporary stop on disclosing information contained in a research paper.
 The embargo process is not automatic; embargoes must be requested by the CPs.
- Embargoes will be automatically lifted after two years (or until scientific publication connected to data is approved: whichever happens first). Up to two-year extensions can be requested.





Data policy implementation in the IMAP Info System

According to UNEP/MAP Data Policy and IMAP Data Policy Annex:

- Datasets
- All monitoring data must be open and published
- Exceptions allowed only if justified
- If delayed without justification:
 - → kind reminders
 - → UNEP/MAP will publish the data



- Publication function
- Until now: Publication by INFO/RAC
- Next step: CPs will publish data by their own









IMAP User Network

- IMAP User Network is the network of IMAP Users responsible to upload, validate and release monitoring data related to IMAP Common Indicators.
- IMAP user Network consists of Country expert representatives, officially appointed by the MAP Focal Point and coordinated by the INFO/RAC NFPs.
- INFO/RAC NFP acts as facilitators among INFO/RAC and IMAP users, allowing the sharing and exchange of knowledge and information for data reporting purposes on IMAP Info System. As facilitators, INFO/RAC NFPs collaborates with INFO/RAC providing suggestion and observations to improve Information Standards.
- Furthermore, INFO/RAC NFPs encourage all national IMAP Users to participate in the Training/Assistance meeting organized by INFO/RAC.





IMAP User profiles

INFO/RAC suggests 3 levels as IMAP User:

Level I - Upload: users uploading the monitoring data file and performing the compliance quality check - *scientific* institutions responsible for data production and elaboration (i.e. monitoring and research institutes).

Level II - Validation: users performing the process of quality control of monitoring data - *national institutions* responsible for data collection and validation (i.e. Environmental National Agency).

Level III - Official release: users have the duty to confirm the official release - national entities responsible for the official release of the data (i.e. National Focal Point).

Nevertheless, Contracting Parties can decide to appoint the same user even for all the 3 levels.
